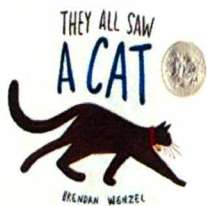
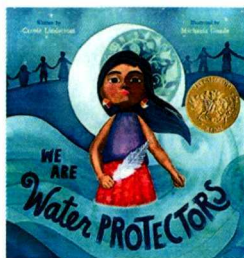

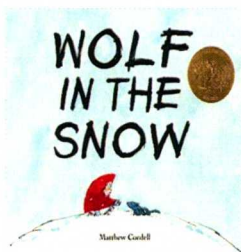
***They All Saw A Cat*** by Brendan Wenzel

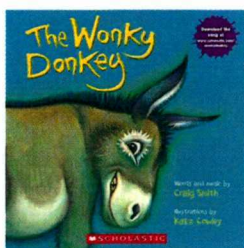
***We Are Water Protectors*** by Carol Lindstrom

***Wolf in the Snow*** by Matthew Cordell

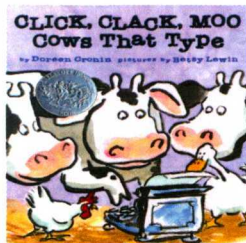
Winner of the 2018 Caldecott Medal

***The Wonky Donkey*** by Craig Smith

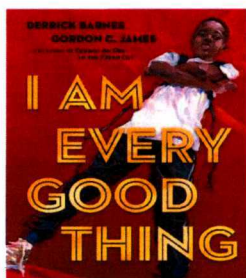

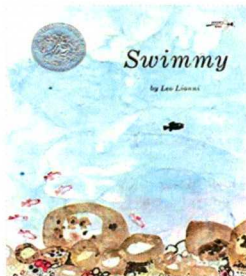
***Click, Clack, Moo Cows That Type*** by Doreen Cronin

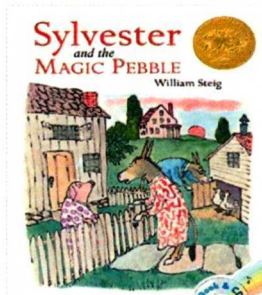
***I AM EVERY GOOD THING*** by Derrick Barnes and Gordon C. James
